Cracow Cuisine

On many streets you'll find ladies selling something that looks like giant pretzels from a blue trolley. They are in fact called "obwarzanek" and are warmed twisted rings of white bread garnished with either poppy seeds, sesame seeds or salt. This is inexpensive Cracow's original "fast food".

Bar culture

Lajkonik

The Lajkonik is one of the unofficial symbols of the city of Crakow. It is represented as a bearded man resembling a Tatar in a characteristic pointed hat, dressed in Mongol attire, with a wooden horse around his waist. It is the subject of the Lajkonik Festival that takes place each year in June.





Wawel hill

A natural limestone hill rising from the plain by the Vistula river, Wawel was the site of Crakow's earliest settlement in prehistoric times due to its strategic advantages. It is a place of great significance to the Polish people as up until 1611 it was a formal residence of Polish Kings. (www.wawel.krakow.pl)



Czartoryski Museum

The Czartoryski collection was started in 1795 by Princess Izabela Czartoryska for the purpose of preserving Polish heritage. The most famous exhibit is undoubtedly Leonardo da Vinci's "Lady With An Ermine". The museum is closed on Mondays (as are many of Crakow's museums) (www.muzeumczartoryskich.krakow.pl).

St. Mary's Altar

St Mary's church on the Main Square has many things to recommend it: its interior is almost overwhelming in its opulence. But surely the highlight must be the 13 meter high 15th century altarpiece by Veit Stoss (Polish: Wit Stwosz), the largest Gothic sculpture in the world. (www.mariacki.com)
